

SeeMe Web Privacy Policy

Effective date: 24 September 2026

This Privacy Policy explains how **SeeMe Web**, a Chrome extension developed by **Inclusify Digital UK Ltd**, handles information when you use the extension.

1. Information we collect

SeeMe Web does not collect, transmit, sell, or share personal information, browsing history, or the content of webpages you visit.

2. Local storage

SeeMe Web uses the Chrome storage permission to save your simulator preferences and visual effect settings within your browser. This allows your selected settings to be retained between uses of the extension. These settings are used only to provide the extension's functionality and are not transmitted by SeeMe Web to Inclusify Digital UK Ltd or to third parties.

3. Website access

SeeMe Web requires access to webpages so that it can display visual simulation overlays on websites. This access is used solely to provide the extension's core function: simulating how different eye conditions and types of sight loss may affect the appearance of web content.

SeeMe Web does not use this access to collect or transmit webpage content, record the websites you visit, or build a browsing profile.

4. Analytics, advertising and third parties

SeeMe Web does not include advertising or analytics and does not sell user information. The extension does not intentionally send user data to external services.

5. Children

SeeMe Web does not knowingly collect personal information from children or adults. Because the extension does not collect personal information, no age-specific personal data is requested through the extension.

6. Eye condition simulation disclaimer

SeeMe Web provides visual representations of the possible effects of eye conditions and sight loss. These simulations are illustrative only. Sight loss can vary significantly between individuals, and the simulations should not be considered an exact representation of how any particular person sees.

SeeMe Web is an awareness and educational tool and is not a medical or diagnostic tool. It should not be used to diagnose an eye condition or to make decisions about medical care.

7. Changes to this policy

This Privacy Policy may be updated if the functionality of SeeMe Web changes. If future versions begin collecting or transmitting information, this policy will be updated to explain those changes before or when the relevant functionality is introduced.
